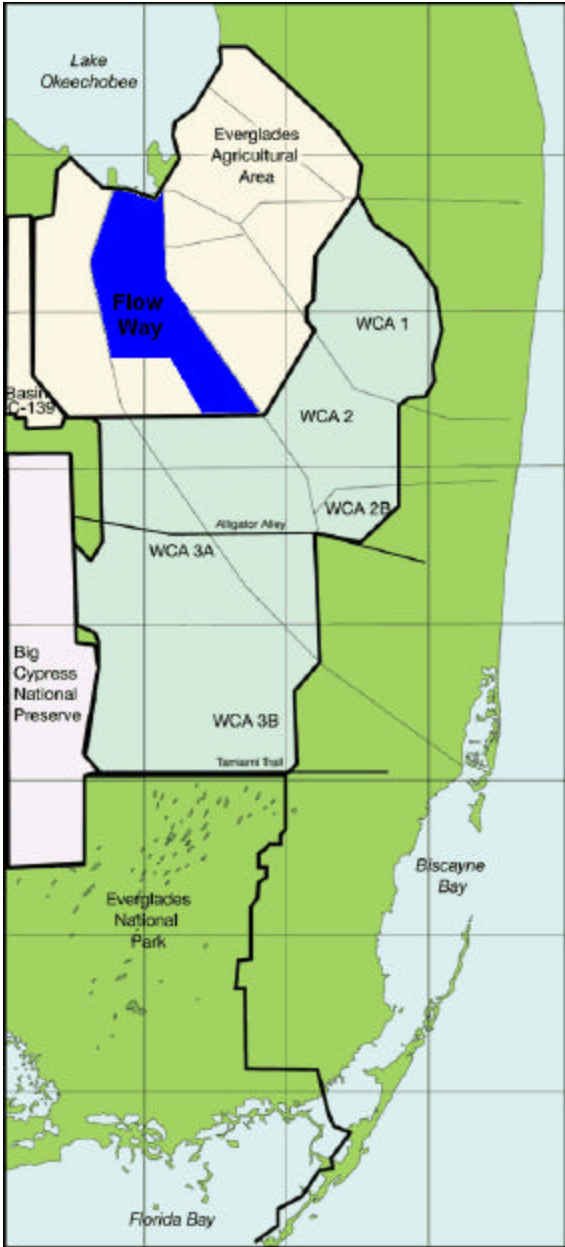
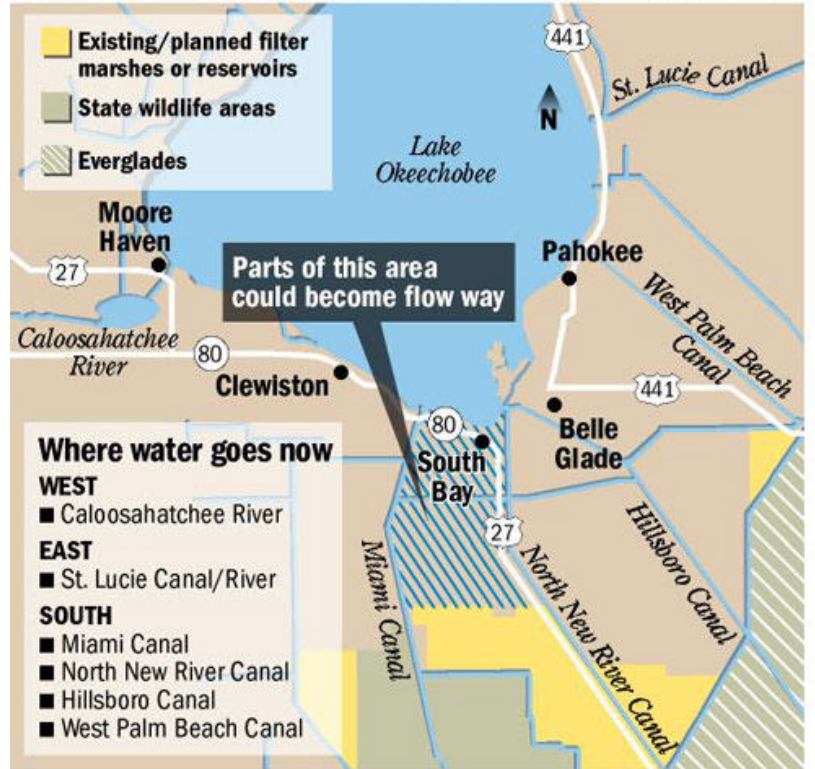


# Plan 6 (Okeechobee-Everglades Flow Way) Background Information
